

# Mesometeorological Observations at ASRCT Sakaerat Experiment Station

(Nakhon Ratchasima)

## ABSTRACT

A general account of the scope and aims of the mesometeorological network of eight stations at the ASRCT Sakaerat Experiment Station is given in Report No. 5 on Research Project 27/1.

Sakaerat Experiment Station is located at approximately latitude  $14^{\circ}30'$  N and longitude  $101^{\circ}55'$  E.

A change in nomenclature has been adopted and the stations have been numbered serially from 1 to 8, as set out below:

The present report summarizes data from these stations during the period November 1967-December 1968. The initial gaps in the record are due to differing dates of commencement of observations. Later gaps are due to observational difficulties.
