ABSTRACT

Glyphosate application twice each year for two years to control shading and competition of water and mineral nutrition in soil of along-alng (*Imperata cylindrica* L.) can improve tree seedling in the replantation area at Sakaerat station. The application rate of 2.2 kilogram a.i. per hectare can eradicate alang-alang for six months. Watering along with urea and microelement application by Drip-culture and spraying on to the tree seedling during winter and summer season (January to April) could obtain excellent growth.
